Dear Parents/Carers,

I wanted to update you with information about how the new term at Trinity Fields will be planned to ensure all pupils and staff are kept safe. Due to the rapidly increasing number of cases, guidance from Welsh Government is rapidly being updated, and we are planning our January return to school in line with current advice.

### Arrangements for start of term:

- Monday 4<sup>th</sup> January: INSET DAY – **No pupils on site**
- Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup>/ Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> January: Risk Assessment Review Days- **No pupils on site**, blended learning provision at home.
- Thursday 7<sup>th</sup>- Monday 18<sup>th</sup> January: Phased return of pupils into school- **Your child's class teacher will let you know the date your child will return for face to face provision.**

**Meals:** Pupils entitled to free school meals will continue to receive deliveries. Pupils having provision on site will need to bring a packed lunch.

**Pupil's health:** if your child is unwell then they **MUST NOT** attend school. Similarly if your child becomes unwell during the day then you **MUST** be able to collect them as soon as possible to ensure other pupils and staff are kept safe.

If any child or member of staff shows any COVID-19 symptoms they should self-isolate and **book a test immediately**. If any member of your household develops symptoms, your child **must** self isolate in line with Welsh Government guidance and will not be able to return until the symptomatic person has a negative test result.
