Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you and your family are keeping safe and healthy. As we move into the last term of the school year, it has been encouraging to see an increasing number of pupils returning to school. I realise that this is still a very uncertain time for many of us but I hope that with an increasing number of adults being vaccinated, along with reduced community infection rates the days ahead might be a little brighter for all of us.

As Wales continues to move towards lifting more of the Coronavirus restrictions it is very important that we continue to work within all of the safety measures that have kept us safe since March 2020; remembering in particular **HANDS-FACE-SPACE-FRESH AIR**. I would also ask you to continue to follow the advice from Public Health Wales by making sure that any children who are unwell for any reason stay at home until they are well enough to come back to school.

As restrictions ease, getting a test is easy and results are usually back within hours. If you are feeling unwell then the advice is to book a test as soon as possible. Following these measures will mean that we all keep safe.

Whitsun holiday: school will close on **Friday 28th May 2021** for Whitsun Holidays. Pupils will return on **Tuesday 8th June 2021** (**Monday 7th June** is a training day for staff).

Training Day: Monday 7th June 2021.

Summer holiday: school will finish for the summer holidays on **Friday 16th July 2021** with pupils returning to school on **Monday 6th September 2021** (Thursday 2nd and Friday 3rd September 2021 will be staff training days).

School website: we are in the process of having a new school website designed. As soon as this is ready these dates will be published on the website, together with all of the dates for the training days for 2021-2022.

Myself and the whole team at Trinity Fields really appreciate all of your support over the last 14 months; like you, we are keen to see things steadily return to more of what we are used to.
