'Trinity Protocol'

Dear Parents/Carers,

Gwent Police Force is piloting a new scheme for children / young people with Additional Learning Needs called 'Trinity Protocol'. This involves personal information such as name, address, medical needs, interests etc. being shared with them and is encouraging some parents from Trinity Fields School to participate.

Please find attached, a form from Gwent Police asking you to share your son/daughters' personal information with them in order to formulate a pen-portrait of them which can be kept on file and then be accessed if necessary. The primary purpose of the protocol is to provide key information about children/young adults who are known to abscond or go missing to emergency services, at times of crisis.

The Trinity Protocol was initially created by CSO Thomas Bingham-Vick after his experience of working within Trinity Fields School before joining the Gwent Police Force. The disappearance of children/young adults with additional learning needs throughout the Gwent Police area allowed him to apply his awareness of additional learning needs to the 'Trinity Protocol'.

The Trinity Protocol is named after Trinity Fields School where CSO Bingham – Vick worked for number of years and where Gwent Police have set up their First Police Cadets in an Additional Needs setting.
