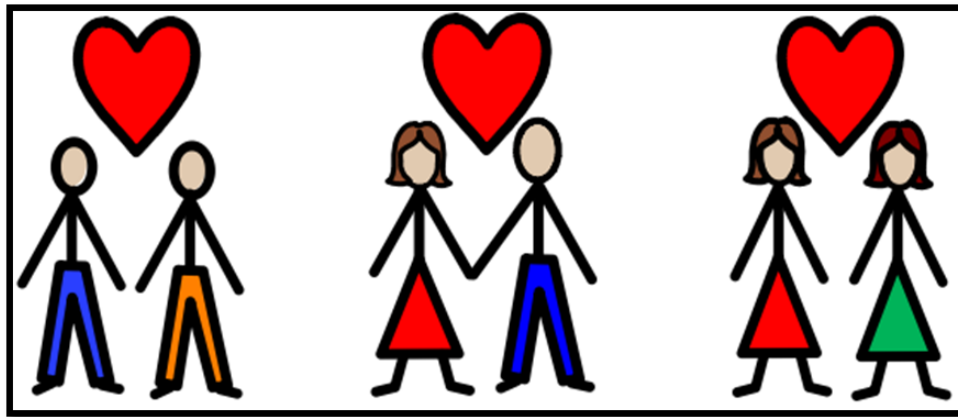


# Relationships and Sex Education (RSE)

3. independent

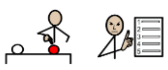

Or you may have some sessions where boys and girls are put into separate groups.





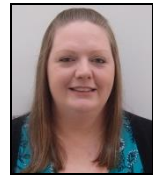

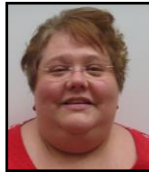

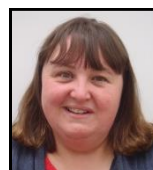
